FIX YOUR BALLMARKS! HERE'S HOW!

n this month's newsletter, I would like to explain the importance of fixing ballmarks on your greens.

Fixing a ballmark takes less than 15 seconds to repair and will heal in 3-4 days. A ballmark not repaired will take two weeks to heal!

If 20 ballmarks are not repaired every day...that's a total of 140 ballmarks a week! That's 560 ballmarks a month! That's 3,360 ballmarks in a six month season! That's a lot of unrepaired ballmarks.
